THREAD -ON-A-SKEWER

What you need:

- ~ Wooden BBQ skewers. The one used here are with handles; see photo on the bottom left. If you use the regular ones, glue a bead at one end.
- ~ Spools of thread, bobbins, beads (e.g.macrame) and glue
- ~ Optional: Small elastic bands and small decorations

Anne Lacasse came up with this great idea to match thread and bobbins to take with a specific project when going on a course or when getting together with friends for a sewing day.

Using BBQ skewers, place a spool of thread and the matching bobbin and secure them in place with a tight fitting bead. Place the mini elastic around the spool and one on the bobbin to stop the thread from getting loose(optional).

If using the skewers with handle, add a mini decoration to personalize your thread-on-a-skewer.
