

NEEDLE CASE

Suzan's
Corner

What you need:

- Two pieces of fabric of your choice about 9 sq.in.
- one piece of batting same size of the fabric
- one piece of felt approximately 6 sq. in.
- one small piece of velcro and thread



How to make it:

Cut 2 pieces of fabric and a piece of batting in a circle about 6 in . diameter. (You don't need batting for the tab). You can modify the shape a bit to make it look like a flower. At one end, leave a tab about 1 1/2"x1 1/2" to add the velcro to keep the case closed.

Place the 2 fabrics right side together and place the batting on top. Sew all around except end of the tab. Make a small V cut between the curves if shaped like a flower. Pull the case through to turn it inside out through the opening of the tab. Fold the end of the tap inside and top stitch all around and sew a small piece of velcro on the inside of the tap and the other piece on the outside opposite side.

Cut the felt in a similar shape but 1" diameter smaller and sew it on the inside in the middle in 8 equal pie shaped sections.



Iron flat and then fold as shown in picture on the left and iron again.

Close using the velcro pieces.
